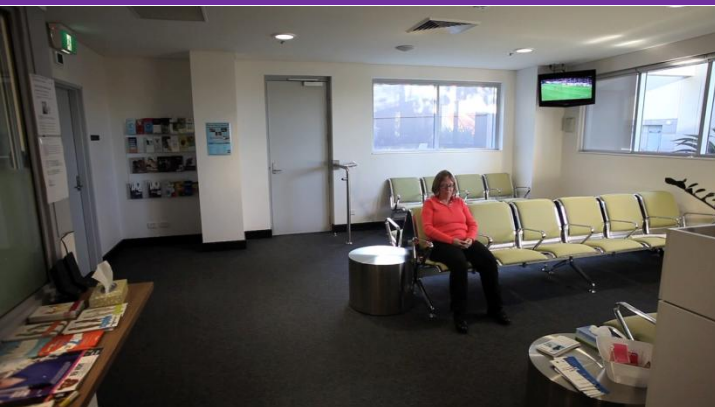


**FREE FILM SCREENING INVITATION**
