This poignant film documents Richard's art practices, relationships, artistic influences and advocacy activities, providing invaluable insights into his journey with mental illness while highlighting his artistry and fortitude.

The film will be presented by Penelope Lee, a mental health clinician and visual artist with a versatile art practice spanning two decades. Bringing her interests together, Penelope has worked at The Dax Centre across research, education, acquisitions, exhibitions, ethics and film production.
